- The LLC staff will be working with our team of developers to build additional components and functionality on the site as well as to clean up data that was migrated from the legacy site in the upcoming months.
- Links to incidents or documents on the legacy site, [wildfirelessons.net](http://wildfirelessons.net), will not work with the new site. New links will need to be generated. The LLC staff is available to help with site navigation to generate new links.
